## Action Words Oral Activity

Goal: Practice action verb vocabulary, language structure patterns.

Level: Multiple

This activity requires an even number of players.

Object—students ask and answer questions to find their match.

### Preparation

- Cut and fold squares.
- Select words and their matching pictures to place in a "hat" so that the total number of squares equals the number of players.

### Activity

- Each player draws one square of paper, concealing it from other players. Each player should have either a word or a picture.
- Players intermingle as they try to find their match, using specific language determined by the level of the class.

Specific language suggestions:

Beginner—use simple constructions you wish to reinforce.

#1 Voudrais-tu \_\_\_\_\_" (use the word written or suggested on square).

#2 "Oui, je veux bien". (a match)

or

"Non, merci, je ne veux pas. (not a match)

Intermediate—use more complex constructions, which require changing the verb form and knowledge of irregular verbs.

#1 "As-tu \_\_\_\_\_?" (fill in past participle of verb on sheet.)

#2 "Non, je n'ai jamais \_\_\_\_\_" or "Oui, bien sûr j'ai \_\_\_\_\_".
