

## Beatrix Potter and Alliteration



Alliteration is what happens when the words in a phrase or a sentence begin with the same letter and sound. Alliteration is used to make writing more interesting. Alliteration is often used in tongue twisters.

Here is an example of an alliteration using a character named Timmy Tiptoes from a Beatrix Potter book, and his name's beginning *T* sound.

**Timmy Tiptoes lived in a tall tree.**


