

## BUBBLE PAINTINGS

### Materials Needed:

- 2 tablespoons of liquid tempera paint any color
- 1 tablespoon of clear dishwashing soap
- a cup of water
- newspapers
- empty jar
- straws
- aluminum pie tin
- markers

### Directions:

Cover your work area with newspapers.

Measure all the ingredients into an empty jar, cover tightly, and shake.

Pour mixture into pie tin.

Stick one end of a straw into mixture and blow through the other end. (Remind children not to suck on the straw, but to blow out).

When a large billow of bubbles forms, remove the straw and carefully lay a sheet of white paper on top. As the bubbles break, they'll leave vivid impressions.

Once the imprint dries, use markers to outline the interesting shapes.

Again, this project would be for three years old and up, as long as they can blow through a straw and know not to suck the mixture up into their mouth.
