

CONSTELLATION PROJECT

Materials needed:

cardboard tube (from wrapping paper, foil wrap, etc.)
rubber band
1 piece of black construction paper
additional paper in your choice of colors
star and other stickers/or crayons
glue

Directions:

1. Cover the outside of the tube with the paper color of your choice and decorate with stickers or crayons.
2. Using the black construction paper, cut out a circle with a 6-8 inch diameter.
3. In the center of the black circle, draw the points (stars) of the constellation (i.e. the “Big Dipper” or any interesting constellation).
4. Use a pin or the point of a sharpened pencil to punch a small hole through each of the drawn points.
5. Wrap the circle over the tube and secure it with a rubber band.
6. Look through the tube at a light to see your constellation.
