### **Painted Easter Eggs**

What you will need:

Boiled eggs  
Paper towels  
Acrylic paint in desired colors  
Cotton balls or paintbrush  
3D glitter paint or other 3D paint (with small tip)  
Toilet paper tubes  
Scissors  
Newspapers or wax paper  
Small container for paint (or use scrap of wax paper)



1. Cover working area with newspapers or wax paper.
2. Cut toilet paper tube to desired height.
3. Dry eggs thoroughly with paper towels.
4. Pour a very small amount of acrylic paint in a container or on a scrap of wax paper. Paint or dab paint on egg using cotton balls or paintbrush. Let dry.
5. Paint toilet paper tube with acrylic paint. Let dry. If using a paintbrush, be sure to wash out the paint.
6. Using 3D glitter paint or another 3D paint, place dots on egg. Let dry.
7. Using 3D glitter paint or another 3D paint, place dots on toilet paper tube. Let dry.
8. Stand egg up on decorated toilet paper tube.

Note: Please make sure to refrigerate eggs promptly if planning on consuming at a later time. Refer to your cookbook for cooking instructions and freshness of eggs.
