### **“Watercolor” Easter Eggs**

What you will need:

Boiled eggs  
Paper towels  
Alcohol inks in desired colors  
Small piece of hook and loop tape with hook side  
(with adhesive back or use strong glue)  
Block or small piece of wood  
White felt scraps  
Toilet paper tubes  
Scissors  
Newspapers or wax paper  
Shampoo (the cheaper the better)



1. Cover working area with newspapers or wax paper.
2. Create “stamp base” by adhering a piece of hook and loop tape (hook side only) to a block or other small piece of wood that will be easy to hold.
3. Cut a piece of white felt and stick to hook and loop tape. (Change out as needed)
4. Dry eggs thoroughly with paper towels.
5. Open alcohol ink and drop single drop of 3 different colors of inks on felt side by side.
6. Lightly dab ink on egg twisting block around to make a “cloudy” effect. Let dry.
7. Cut toilet paper tube to desired height.
8. Take one end of felt that has a single color on it and dab on the toilet paper tube and let dry.
9. Stand egg up on decorated toilet paper tube.
10. Wash hands with shampoo. The cheaper shampoos seem to be more effective at cleaning hands.

Note: Please make sure to refrigerate eggs promptly if planning on consuming at a later time. Refer to your cookbook for cooking instructions and freshness of eggs.
