

## EAT YOUR ART WORK (PEANUT BUTTER CLAY)

### Materials Needed:

- 2 cups of creamy peanut butter
- 2 cups of powdered milk,
- 1/3 cup honey
- large bowl
- large spoon
- waxed paper

### Directions:

Wash hands first.

Mix the peanut butter and the powdered milk in a large bowl.

Add the 1/3 cup of honey to sweeten the dough and stir until dough is shapeable. If the dough is too sticky, add powdered milk to make it stiffer. If it is crumbly, add a little more honey.

Spread out on a large sheet of waxed paper and let your child create their own edible sculptures. You can make a smaller amount of the peanut butter clay by using half of the ingredients.

Be prepared, though, this can get messy, but kids love it.
