

LET'S GO FISHING



Materials Needed:

- yard stick
- stick or wrapping paper tube for pole
- string
- masking tape
- small magnet
- cardboard
- picture of a fish from a magazine or coloring book
- large paper clip

Directions:

1. Attach two feet of string to your tube or yardstick with masking tape to make a “fishing pole”.
2. Tie a magnet at the end of the string.
3. Cut out fish from cardboard.
4. Glue or attach a large paper clip on the front of the fish.
5. Place the fish on the floor. Try fishing with your pole.

You can make extra fish and have a box or bucket to put the fish in.

Variation:

1. Instead of using a magnet at the end of the string, you can attach a pipe cleaner curved into a hook shape. Punch a hole in the front of the fish and try to catch them by inserting the hook into the hole.

You can increase or decrease the size of the hole in the fish depending on what age group you're working with.
