### **Postage Stamp Storage Box**

This recycled project works not only as a decorative item, but also as a storage container for small game items, crafts, or supplies.

What you will need:

Processed cheese spread box (or any box with a top and bottom)  
Used postage stamps  
Adhesive: school glue or tacky glue  
Clear contact paper, optional



1. Remove bottom of box and set aside.
2. Glue stamps all over the box. Let dry completely.
3. Have an adult use contact paper to cover the lid. This will help with loose ends that may not get glued down firmly. It will also make the box last longer without losing the stamps in the process.
4. Place items in the box and replace lid.

Note: If desired, make labels and label the contents of the box. This box could hold miniature craft items that a child would make, game pieces, or other small items. Multiple boxes should stack nicely and keep everything in place.
