Recycled Paper Holder

Use this paper holder to hold school papers or reports in progress. We recommend not covering the inside of the cereal box as it will allow more room for the papers to sit up straight.

What you will need:

Cereal box

Scissors

Pencil or marker

Construction paper in your choice of colors

Adhesive: school or tacky glue

Small piece of cardboard (to use as a squeegee)



1. Cut the top off of the cereal box.
2. Cut down the narrow side of the cereal box to about 4-5" from bottom. Cut this side off as shown in photograph.
3. Cut wide sides of cereal box at an angle, if desired.
4. Cover one side of cereal box with glue, using a piece of cardboard like a squeegee to evenly spread the glue across the box.
5. Lay a piece of construction paper on the box. Press firmly from the inside of the box.
6. Cut around the box so the paper is even.
7. Repeat for other 3 sides of the box.
8. Let dry completely.
9. Use the box to store papers or a report. Add your name or project name if desired.
