

Bunny Bottle Flower Vase

Instruction Sheet

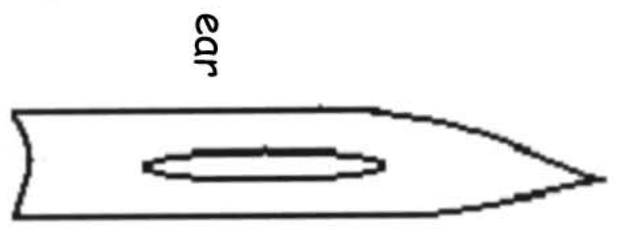
Materials Needed:

- clean empty bottle [plastic works best and is safer for kids]
 - construction paper
 - markers
 - glue
 - one cotton ball
 - flowers for vase [optional]
 - spray paint [optional]
1. If desired, an adult can coat the clean empty bottle with spray paint in advance. [spray paints should only be used in a well ventilated area.]
 2. Enlarge pattern as needed to fit your bottle size. Cut out the pattern pieces.
 3. Glue "body" low on the bottle.
 4. Add two "back legs" to the bottle, to look as if they touch the floor.
 5. Add two "paws" to each side.
 6. Create an appropriate face on the "head" using markers.
 7. Attach face and two "ears" to bottle.
 8. Add strips of paper for whiskers.
 9. Attach one cotton ball to back for tail.
 10. Allow to dry.
 11. Add water and carnations for an adorable centerpiece!

Try adding one small silk flower to your bunny paw, as if he is holding a flower!

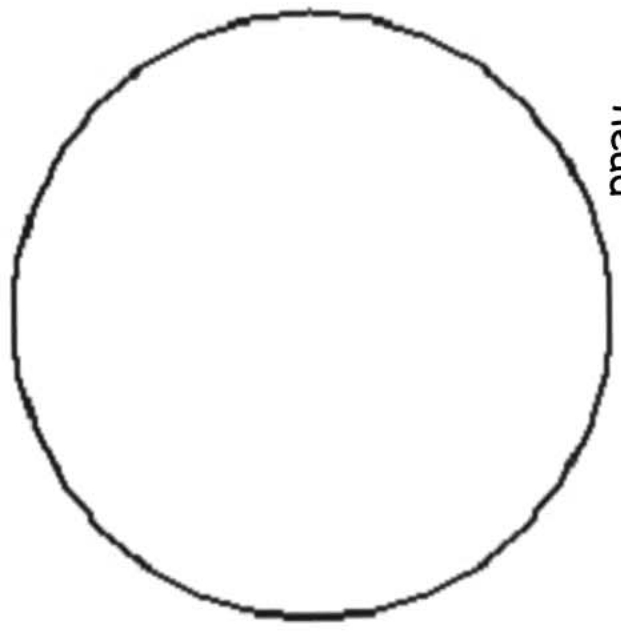

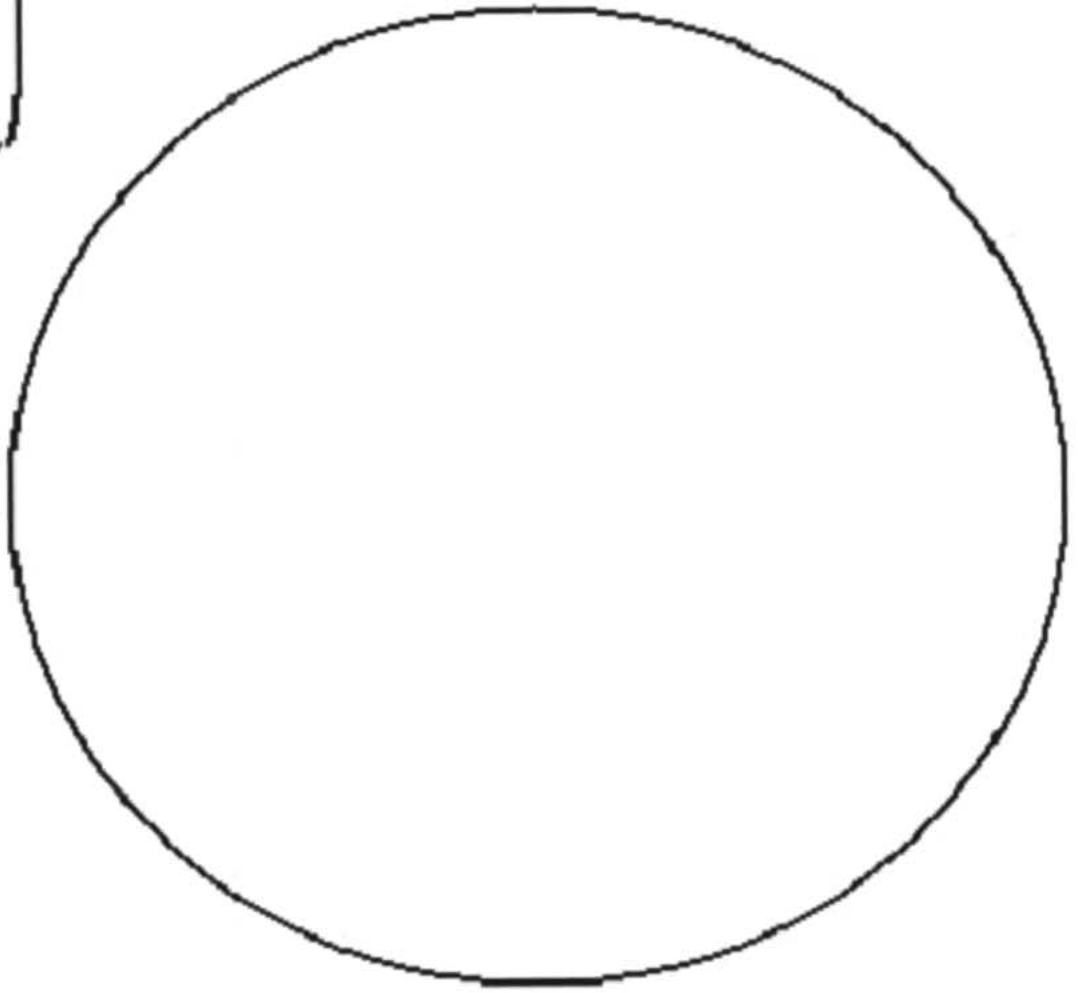
ear
