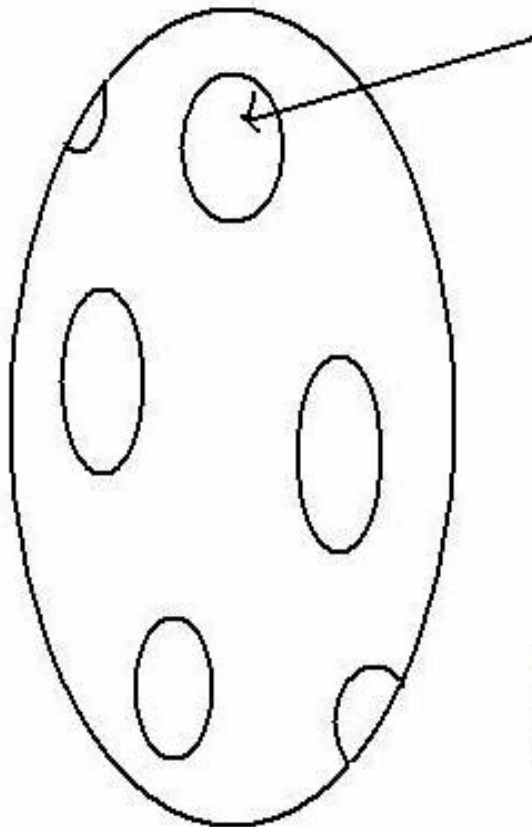
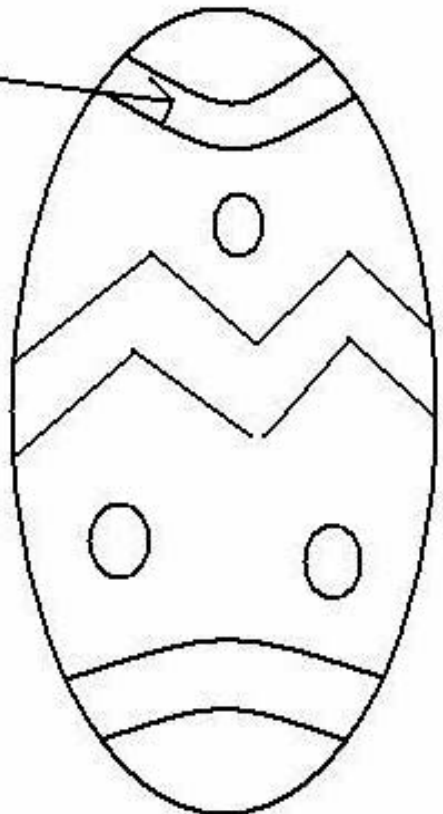


Tissue Paper "Stained Glass" Eggs *pattern*

Tissue Paper "Stained Glass" Eggs

Instruction Sheet

Materials Needed:

- construction paper
- tissue paper in assorted colors
- scissors
- glue stick

1. Enlarge patterns to desired size.
2. For each egg, cut two identical egg pattern pieces from construction paper.
3. Cut out the exact same design on each egg. See *pattern* for design ideas. If you choose to cut lines (as in the more difficult pattern example), you will have to work with pieces of the eggs, like a puzzle. Although more complicated, the results are worth it!
4. Cut pieces of tissue paper large enough to completely cover the "holes" in the design you have cut. Use the glue stick to attach the tissue paper to one of the eggs. Use a different color of tissue for each area of design you have cut out. For example, each circle can be a different color of tissue.
5. Place the other construction paper egg on top to line up exactly, making a kind of sandwich, with the tissue paper in the middle. Use the glue stick to attach. The tissue paper should show through the cut designs.
6. Hang in a well-lit window for a spectacular stained glass display!

Try decorating the construction paper parts of the egg with a glitter glue pen... or use white construction paper that you have water colored.
