

Easter Basket Windsock

Instruction Sheet

Materials needed:

- construction paper (8 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 17 and extra for pattern pieces)
- party streamers
- masking tape
- scissors
- single hole punch
- glue or glue stick
- stapler
- easter basket grass or strips of green paper
- markers, crayon or chalk
- yarn

1. Roll construction paper into a tube as shown in diagram. Staple securely.
2. Use hole punch to make three to five holes at regular intervals along the top edge of the construction paper tube.
3. String the yarn through the holes (as shown in the example page), gathering at top/center to hang.
4. Attach long strips of streamers to the bottom edge of the tube, taping them inside the tube so that it doesn't show from the outside. Streamers should be long --three feet is ideal!
5. Cut out a basket shape, and decorate it with markers to resemble a "basket weave" pattern. (Use a ruler if needed.)
6. Cut out three to five egg shapes and decorate them as Easter eggs.
7. Glue the basket onto the construction paper tube (where the "X" is shown on the example page), leaving room for eggs and grass on top.
8. Glue the decorated eggs and grass onto the basket.
9. Finish with a bow!

Try using glitter paint for great looking eggs!
