

Gigantic Bubbles



Materials Needed:

- Wire coat hanger or pipe cleaners
- Pan
- dishwashing soap
- corn syrup

Directions:

1. Bubble Mixture - Combine six cups of water, two cups of dishwashing liquid, three-quarters of a cup of corn syrup (This gives the bubbles added strength)
2. Make the bubbles four hours in advance of playtime.
3. Pour into a shallow pan.

note: You can halve this recipe for smaller groups.

To Make the Wands

1. Reshape wire hangers to ovals, circles, hearts, etc. Leave the handle as is.
2. You can also make smaller shape wands from pipe cleaners, such as stars. The pipe cleaner wands are better for small children to use, and are easier for indoor use. For outdoor use the coat hanger is great.

If you are you doing this with very small children, the adult should hold the wire hanger and dip into the pan (or even a child's swimming pool would work great for the bigger bubbles) and the children can chase the bubbles.
