

Cut cards and laminate if desired.

Three in a Row

3 to 6 players

All the cards are dealt out as equally as possible to the players.

Object:

In this Go Fish type game, players try to gather the three principal parts of the irregular verbs and lay them down *Three in a Row*.

Ex. GO WENT GONE

The first player asks any other player for a specific word card. If the answer is "yes", the card is handed over and the first player continues; if not the turn passes to the player who was asked.

As in Go Fish, you must have at least one card of the trio you ask for. Complete sets of 3 cards are laid on the table *Three In A Row*. The cards should be in the proper sequence of *present-past-past participle*. The game continues until all the cards are lying on the table *Three In A Row*. Whoever has the most trios wins. An alternative is to score one point per trio and play to a target score.
