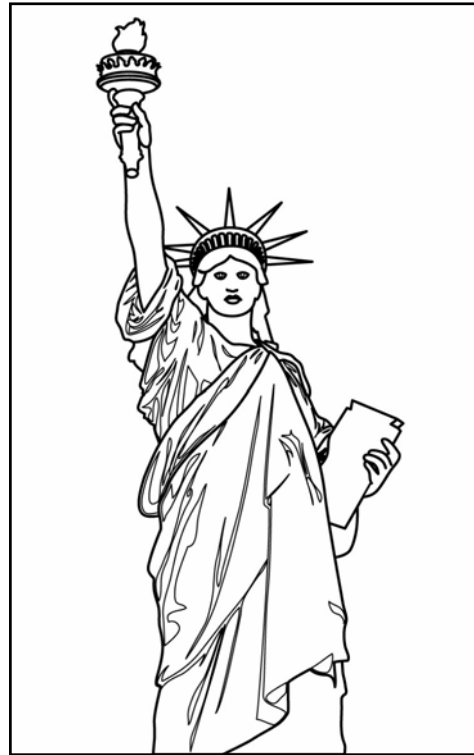

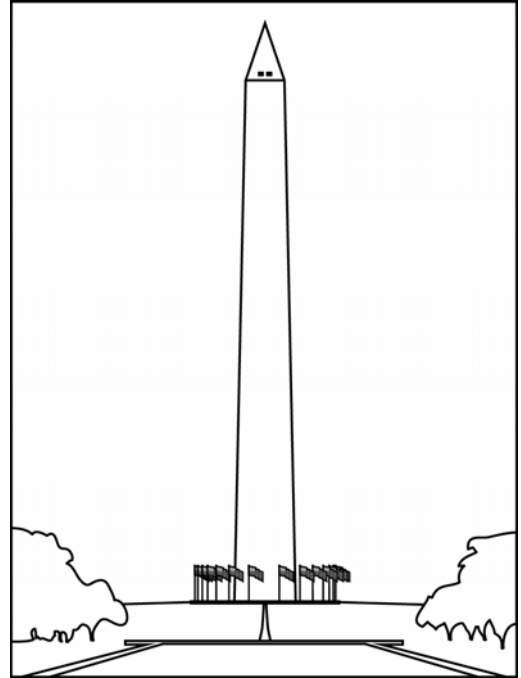

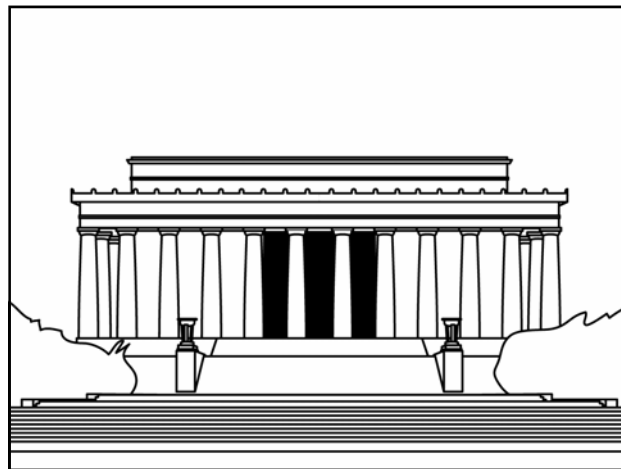
The United States of America has

The Washington Monument is a tribute to George Washington. It is in Washington, D. C.

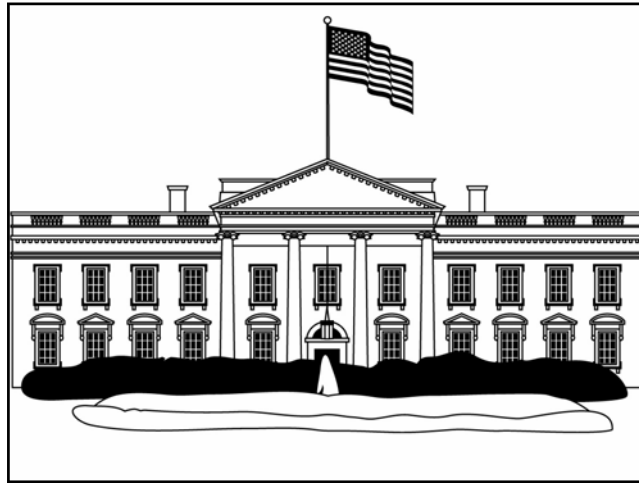

The Lincoln Memorial honors Abraham Lincoln. It is also in Washington, D. C.

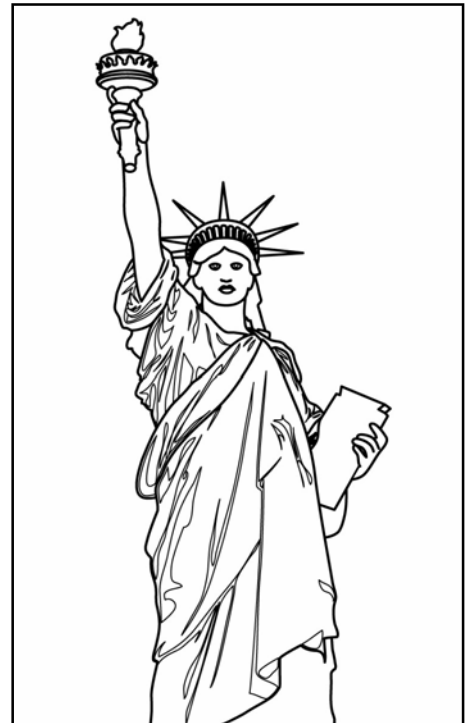

The White House is the home of the President. It is also in Washington, D.C.

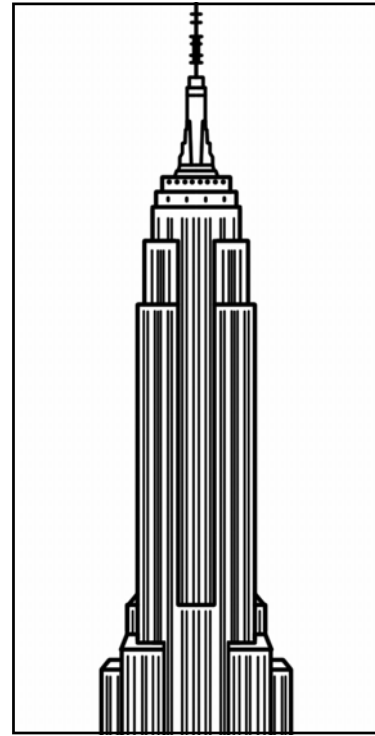

The Statue of Liberty stands in New York Harbor. It was a gift from France in 1886.



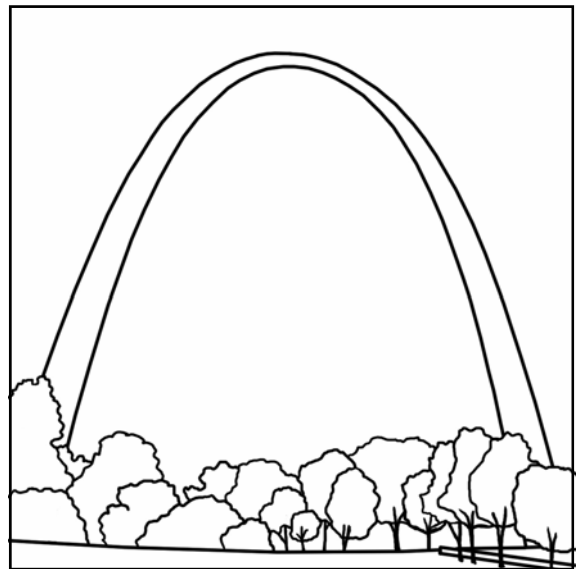

The Empire State Building is the tallest building in New York City. It was built in 1931.

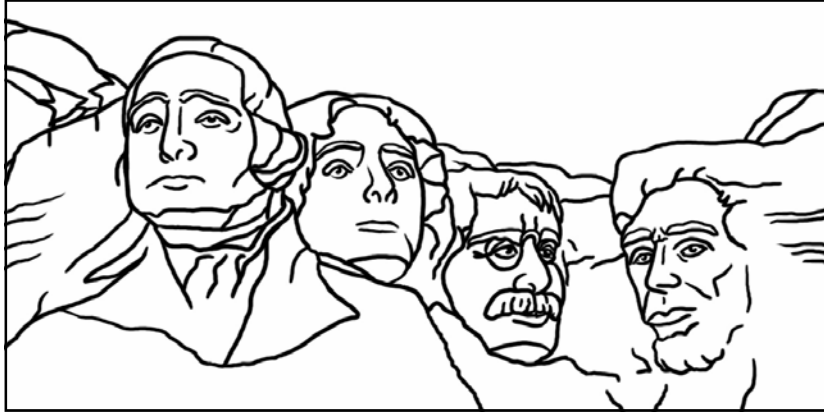

The Gateway Arch is in St. Louis, Missouri. It is also called the Gateway to the West.

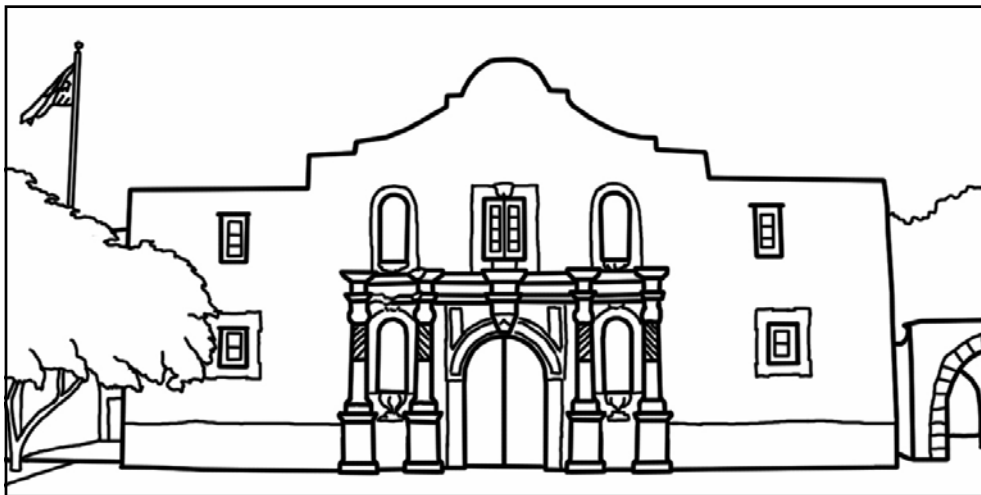

Mount Rushmore is a monument to four presidents. The faces are carved into a mountain in South Dakota.

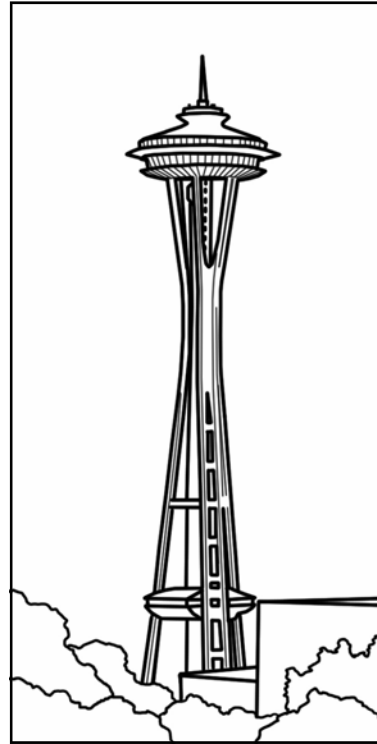

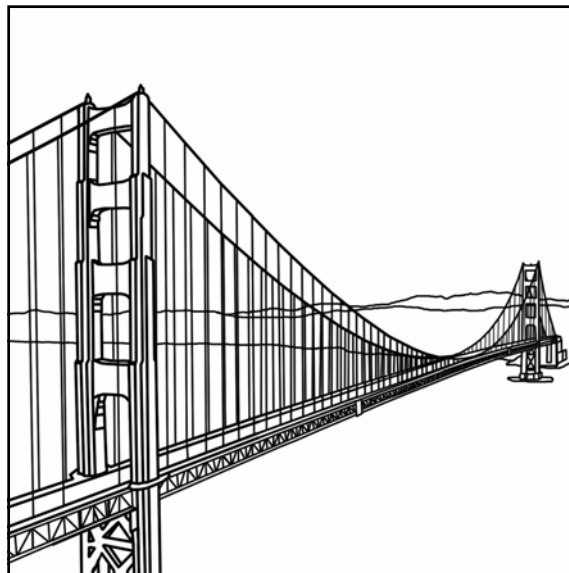
The Alamo is the site of a famous battle in San Antonio, Texas.
