

## Alphabet Puzzles

**Suggested audience:**

PreK- 1

**Object:**

Review alphabet letters and words that begin with each letter by putting together a puzzle.

**Available Materials:** (pages can be downloaded individually or as a complete set for each letter)

Black-and-white puzzle with 4-5 pieces

Black-and-white puzzle with 8-10 pieces

Black-and-white "guide" picture

Color puzzle with 4-5 pieces

Color puzzle with 8-10 pieces

Color "guide" picture

**Directions:**

There are several ways to use these alphabet puzzles. For durability, the puzzles should be copied or mounted on to heavy paper. They can also be laminated for greater durability. Heavy paper and tag board should be cut out by an adult. Simple paper copies of the two first puzzles (4-5 pieces) can usually be cut out by students. The second two puzzles (with 8-10 pieces) are complicated and should be cut out by an adult or older student.

These puzzles are a great addition to an alphabet center, to a "letter day" theme day, to an activity center, etc. They make colorful signs (or students can each color their own signs). They can be added to an alphabet book. The black-and-white versions make good coloring activities.
