

## FAIRY TALE ALLITERATIONS

**Alliteration** is what happens when the words in a phrase or a sentence begin with the same letter and sound. Alliteration is used to make writing more interesting. It is also used to write tongue twisters.



Here is an example of an alliteration using the word **WITCH** and the beginning **W** sound:

Wicked witches want wriggling worms to remove warts.
