5. *Brandy mailed four packages. The postage on the first three was \$2.65 each. The postage on the fourth package was \$4.37.*

- What was the total amount Brandy spent on postage?

6. *Tim had 3,090 M&M's. He gave 1,295 to his teacher. He ate 277.*

- How many M&M's did Tim have left?
