



Instructions: "Tell Two Things You Do..."

Print the two game boards. Fold the appropriate margin under on one sheet and lay over the other sheet so the trail matches. Tape and laminate if desired.

Divide into teams (two to six players). The game requires one die per team and a place marker for each player.

Players roll the die in turn and move the number of places indicated. Each player must either follow the instructions in the box or name two things indicated.

Failure to name two things that they do will result in a lost turn. The first player to arrive at "Finish" wins the game.
