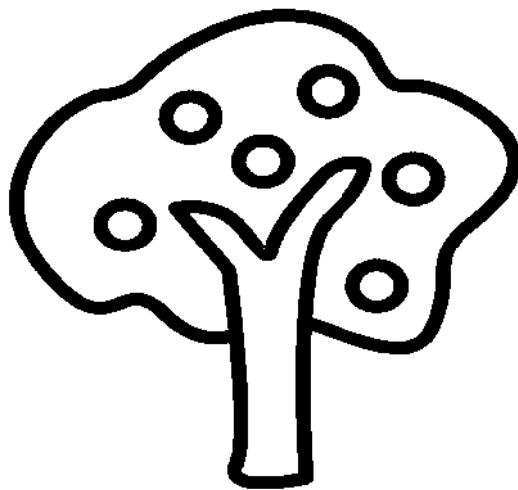
1 apple tree worksheet

Apple Orchard Wordsheet

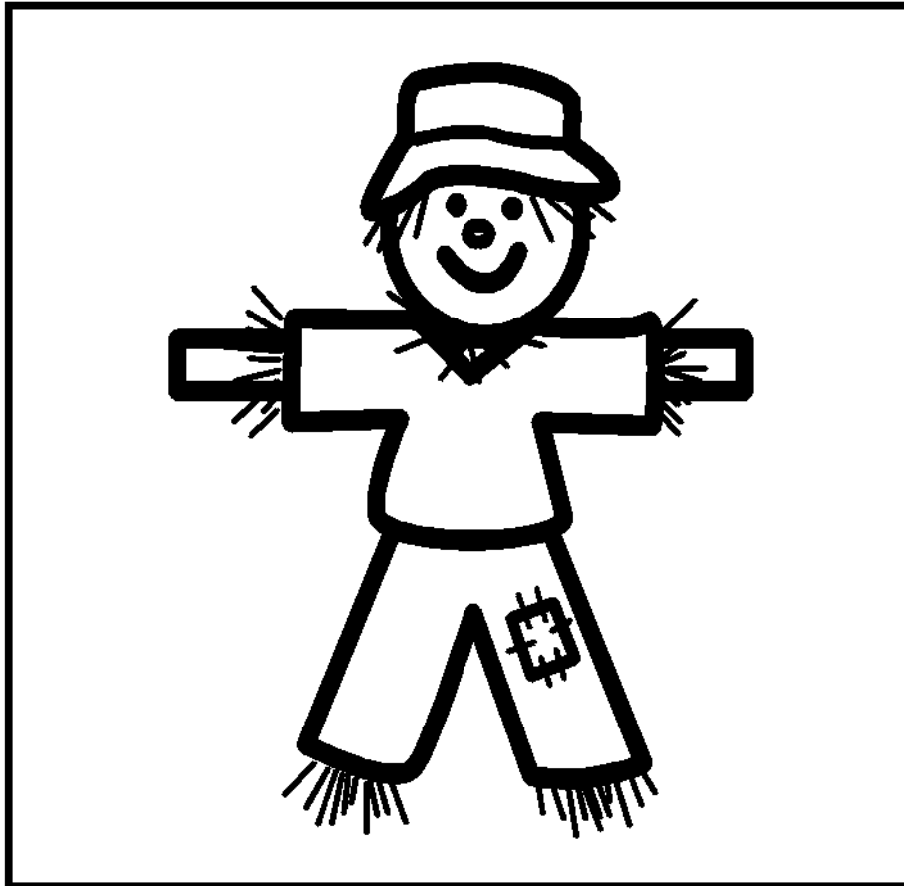
1. Use the brown paper to create a tree trunk, with limbs.

Teachers: Use these trees to transform your bulletin board into an apple orchard.

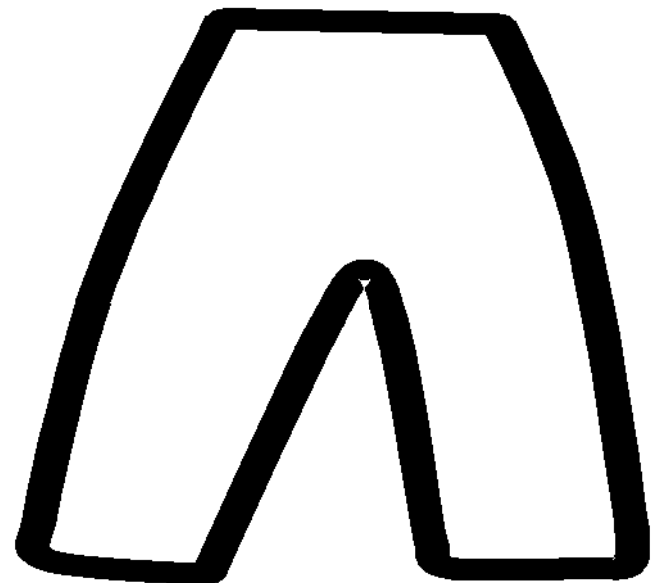
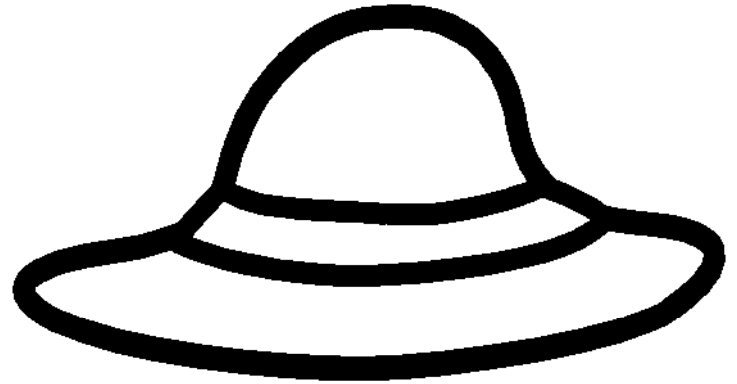
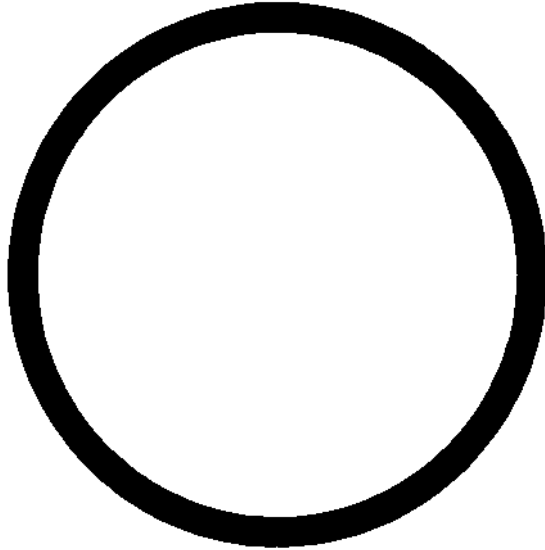
Fall Harvest Center 2

Make a Scarecrow!



You will need:
Scarecrow patterns
1 piece of paper
Glue
Scissors
Straw or yarn
Markers

1. Cut out each pattern and color it.
2. Cut straw (or yarn) in 6 inch strips.
3. Glue the patterns on a piece of paper.
4. Add the straw to complete your scarecrow.



Fall Harvest Center 3

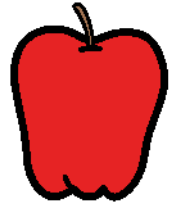
