How much light does your planet have and how does your alien adapt to it?

Does your alien have a name?

Draw a picture of your “alien life” form. Be sure to include as many of your adaptations as you can in your drawing.

Many monuments have sayings on the front of them that helps those viewing the monument understand the purpose of the monument. What saying or message would you place on your monument?
