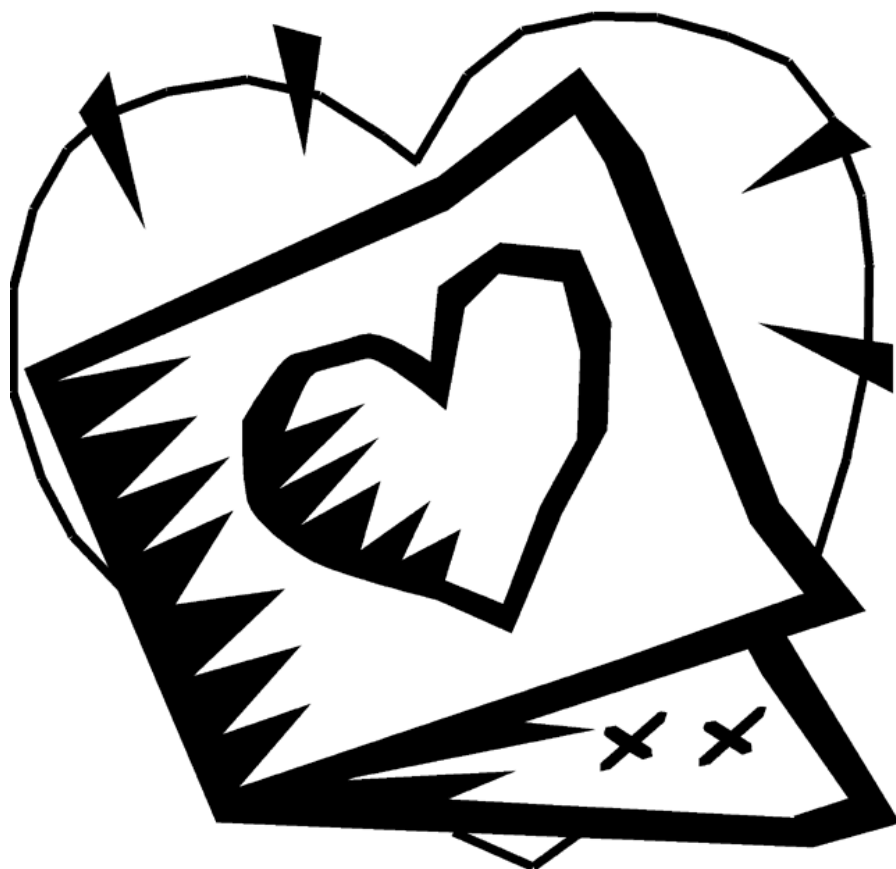


You will need:

Sequence of Events:

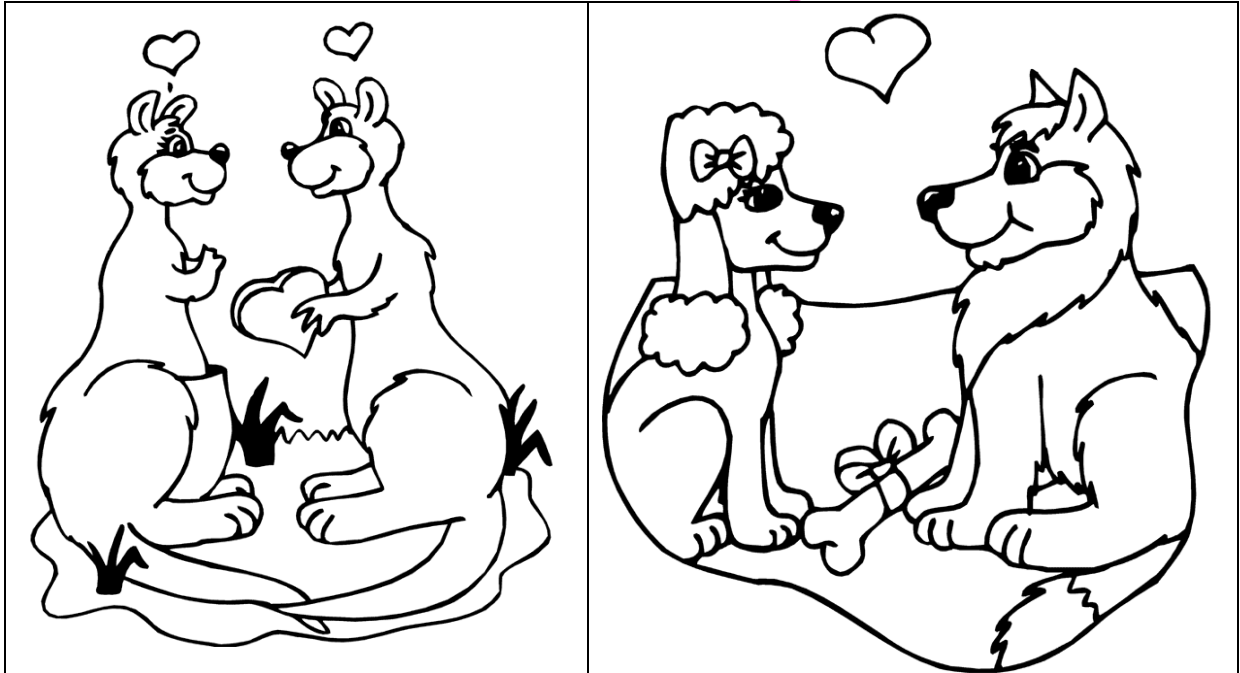
You will need.

Read the event strips. Put them in the correct sequence.

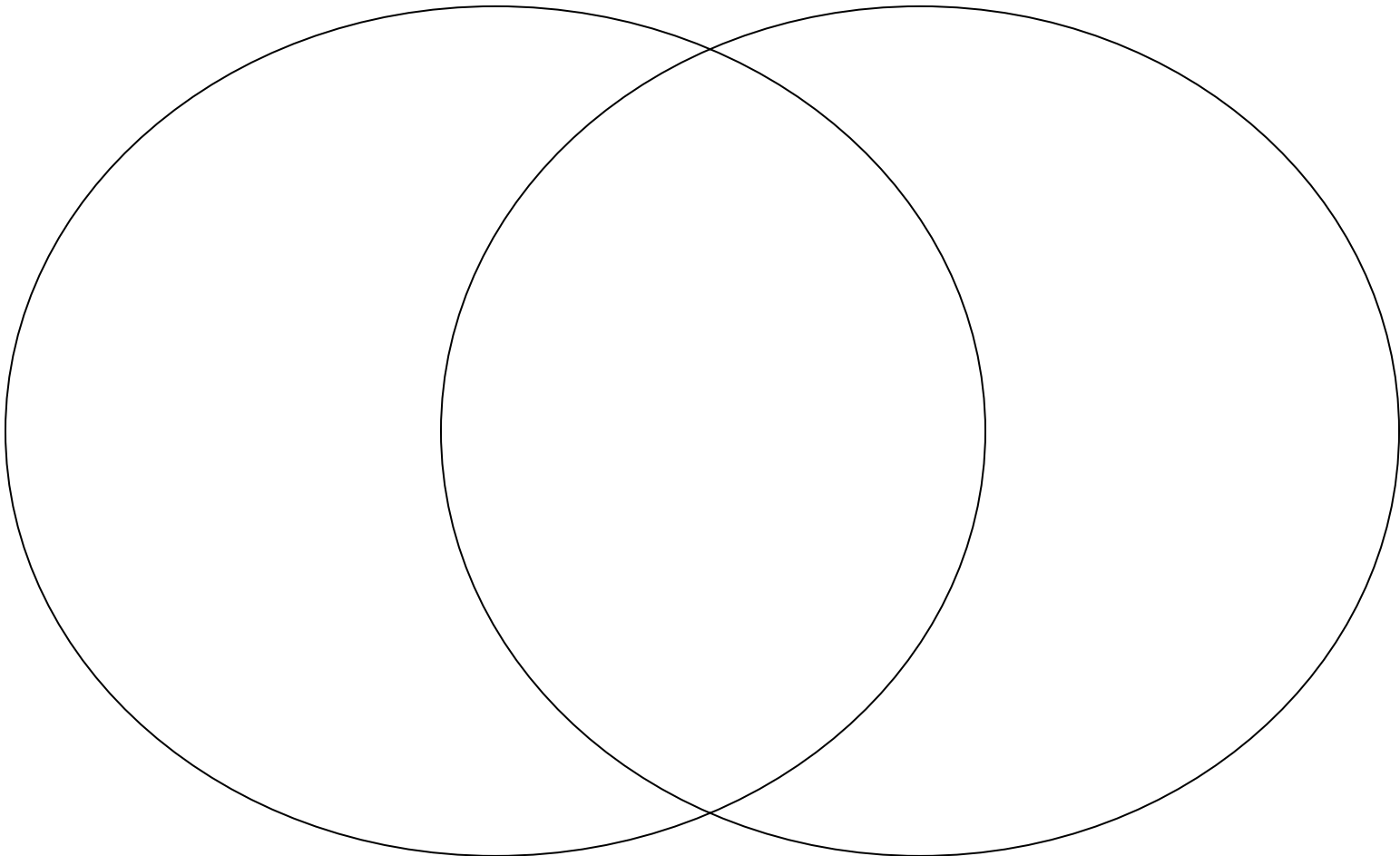
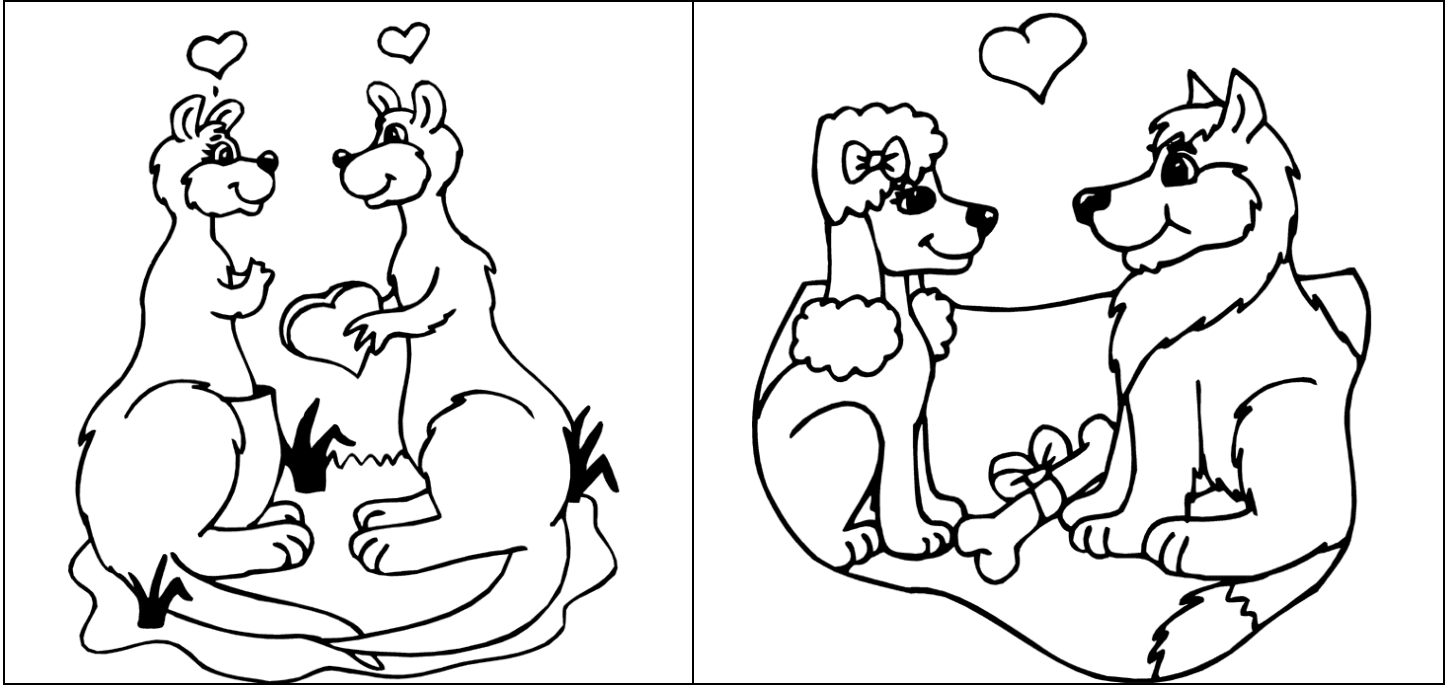

Pencil and crayons**

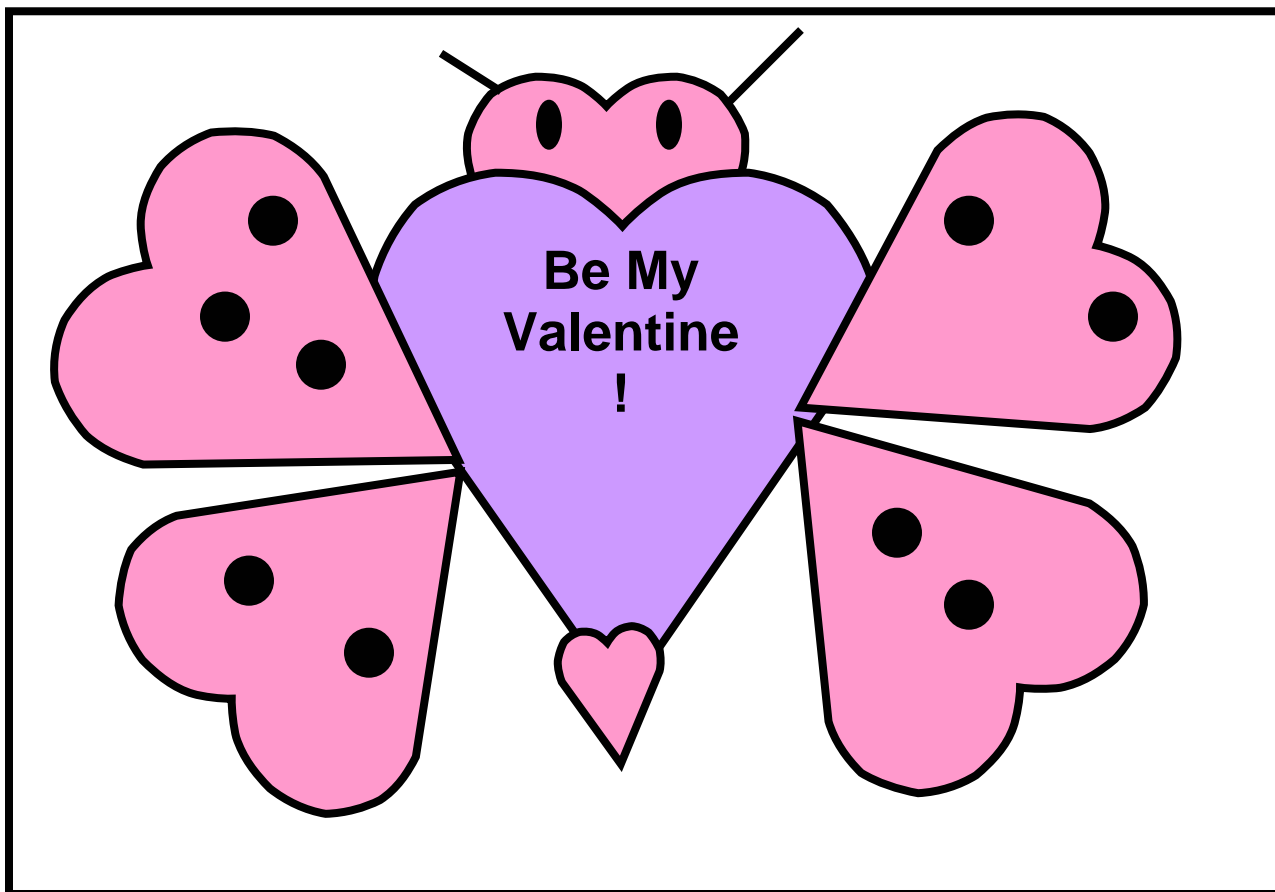
Color each picture. Use the Venn diagram to compare the two valentines.

Valentine Directions:



You will need:

- Red , black, pink, and white construction paper
- Small pieces of white and red paper.
- Glue
- Scissors
- Pencil or marker



Directions:

- Cut out different sized hearts in red, white, or pink.
- Paste the hearts on a piece of black paper to create the shape of a butterfly.
- Cut out small hearts, dots, or other shapes to decorate the wings.
- Cut out two hearts or dots for eyes.
- Cut out and paste antennae.
